

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR A MOBILITY (Erasmus + or FAME)

SELECTION :

In accordance with the rules edicted by the 'Agence Erasmus francophone (AEF-Europe)', The students applying for a mobility are selected according to the following criteria :

- 1) Language skills : knowledge of the working or teaching language from the host country (according to the CEFR). The student level will be assessed by the Erasmus + OLS (Online Linguistic System) tool or by language teachers from the HEAJ. If need be, the international service can impose a language test in its office (rue Godefroid, 32 à Namur). The minimum level to acquire is B1 for an internship and B2 for a study period.
- 2) Satisfactory academic results : results from January and from the previous academic years.

In case of insufficient results, the application from a student can be refused.

For the technical department, a portfolio can also be required. For the pedagogical department, succeeding the placement period is absolutely necessary.

- 3) Motivation and objectives : based on the application form + participation to the courses
- 4) Autonomy and personality : based on the reference teachers' opinion

Important remarks :

- The grants are firstly attributed to students going to a country different from their origin country.
- To be eligible for a study period, selected students must have validated all their « UE » (teaching unit) before their stay.
- For the economics department, the final year project's topics for the applicants wishing to leave for a study period will have to be transmitted for June 1st at the latest. Otherwise, the students will be suppressed from the list of applicants.

The final decision will be communicated within 15 days after the application deadline by the department's international representative after having taken opinion from a council of concerned teachers.
